





Apply correct amount of nutrients for each crop to avoid damaging the environment




SUSTAINABLE CARBON CYCLES




Post project life (1)

- Algae Service for Life a promising example/good practice of turning environmental threats into the business opportunities
- Indications: excess carbon, nutrients and warming climate will continue



Post project life (2)

- Important to elaborate **viable market applications** from algae blooms biomass e.g.
 - Algae wrist campaign
 - Algae blooms products (algae foam) already on the market e.g.
 Adidas, Levis, Reebok
- Biomethane production very unlikely to have market potential and be cost-effective within next decade(s).



Post project life (3)

- Defensives...zooplankton, zoobenthos harvested with blooms...?
- The Green Advisory Service for Sustainable Investments Support (Green Assist) is (new advisory initiative under <u>InvestEU</u> - funded <u>LIFE</u>).
- BlueInvest well known as "Baltic Environment" presentation was selected for pitch at the first ever algae-focused BlueInvest e-pitch event
- Multiple funds to check for future projects e.g. Horizon Europe, CBE JU, EMFF shared management



Commissions role to support algae sector

- EU Algae Initiative —a set of well-advancing coordinated actions to unlock algae potential in the EU
- MS authorities are invited to recognise huge algae sector potential in EU and significantly increase the support to the sector
- EU4Algae an EU flagship for algae sector and for implementation of the EU Algae Initiative
- Investments instrumental for emerging sector to derisk investments
- European Commission is here to help: assistance mechanisms, funds, guidelines etc
